Please remember:

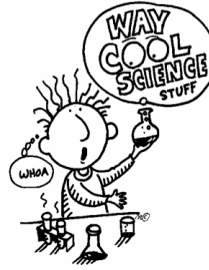
- All students need 2 or 3 sharp pencils, an eraser and a ruler for every exam.
- Years 5 and 6 students are allowed a calculator for Maths 2 exam only.

It is important to be prepared. Here are some tips for the morning of each exam day:

- ✓ Prepare your things the night before (pencils, erasers, etc.)
- ✓ Wake up early enough for your mind and body to be fully awake by the time you get to school.
- ✓ Eat a good breakfast. Your mind and body need fuel to do well.
- ✓ Warm up your brain by reading something enjoyable while you are eating your breakfast. Do not try to study everything the night before or in the morning. This will make you worried and upset before the exam even begins!

Science Fair

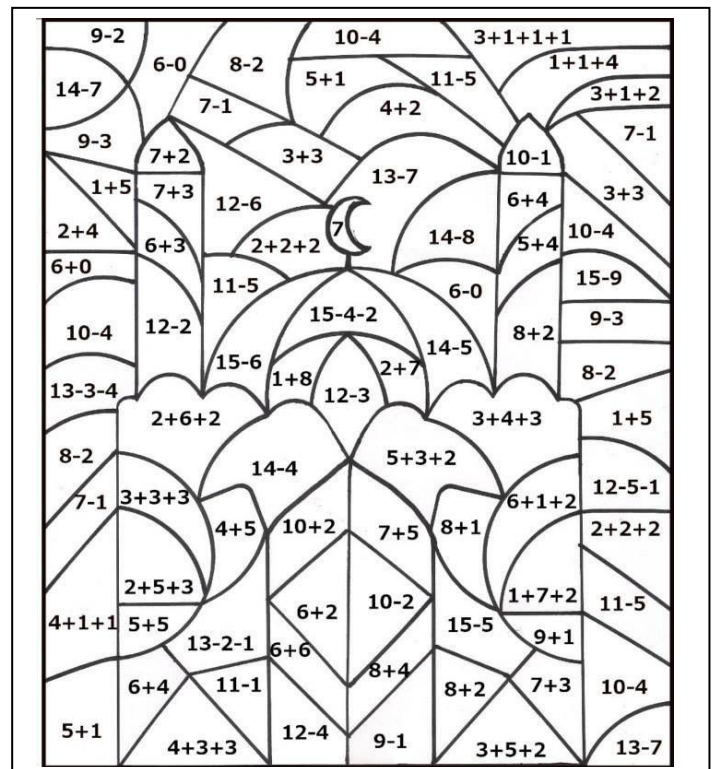
BSB will be having its annual Science Fair on Thursday, 7 June. All families are invited to visit the fair at 1:45pm.
