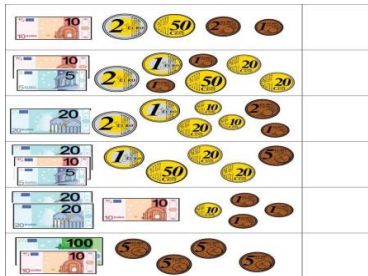

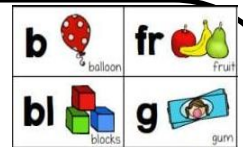

What is a volcano?



A volcano is a type of mountain that emerges from the earth's crust through which hot volcanic ash and gases escape.

A volcano becomes active when it erupts. An eruption is when lava and gas are released from a volcano.

Volcanoes emit rocks that can reach 4000 kilometres high. Volcanoes also emit fire which can reach temperatures between 700-1300 degrees.
